BUSINESS AND SUPPORT SERVICES SAFETY BOMB THREATS

1. RESPONSE TO THREATS

In the event that any Tintic School District employee or student receives a threat notice or is informed or has a reasonable belief that an explosive or incendiary device is located or may be activated on or near Tintic School District property or in the vicinity of a District or school function or activity, the employee or student shall immediately notify the school Principal or District Official at the location of the function, activity or school. The Principal or District Official, shall upon receiving notice of the threat which appears from the circumstances to have some basis in fact,

A. Call local law enforcement agencies and report the information, and

B. Evacuate the building or area according to preplanned emergency evacuation procedures. Emergency evacuation procedures shall be formulated as part of the Tintic School District and individual school emergency preparedness plans.

2. REPORTING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT

All threats regarding the activation or detonation of any explosive or incendiary device on Tintic School District property or in the vicinity of school functions or activities shall be reported to law enforcement.

3. EMPLOYEE AND STUDENT PROHIBITIONS

No Tintic School District employee or student shall for any reason whatsoever initiate threats to detonate or activate any explosive or incendiary device on District property or at school functions or activities.
