Feb. 12, 2019 Proposed Amendments

Goal #1 82% of our students will read on or above grade level or make at least one years progress by the end of the 2018-2019 school year.

Amendment Proposal

This year for our book club party we are having an illustrator and author come and our cost for both of them will total \$1400 and we only budgeted \$500. The carry-over we had from last year's plan going into this school year was \$4,400 which will cover this cost.

Goal #2 83% of our students will be on grade level or make one years progress in their math ability.

Amendment Proposal

We want to send 6 teachers to a math instructional workshop for training on a math program that we want to incorporate next year. This costs \$1,900 and we would like to propose that we take that out of the carry over funds as well.

Amendment Proposal

We proposed to change the measurement for K-2 students on our math goal to use i ready math assessment for the grades K-2 and keep the Moby Max assessment for the grades 3-6.
