## 1. ADMITTANCE OF FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Foreign exchange students may enroll in Tintic School District schools provided they have met all the criteria established by the Utah State Office of Education and their sponsoring institution.

## 2. HONORARY DIPLOMAS

It is the policy of the Tintic School District that Foreign Exchange students will receive an honorary high-school diploma unless appealed by the student to the graduation committee prior to entering Tintic High School or West Desert High School. If the Foreign Exchange student wishes to appeal, he/she must submit a copy of their high-school transcript to the Utah State Office of Education prior to May of the year they plan on attending a Tintic School District school.

## 3. TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION

The Utah State Office of Education will review and evaluate the transcript and will provide a report to the Tintic School District. Upon receipt of this report, the District will work with the student to set up the necessary classes required to graduate from the Tintic School District. The student must meet all requirements needed for graduation in order to receive a diploma.
