### **STUDENT CONDUCT**

#### **BUS CONDUCT**

---

##### **1. CONDUCT PROVIDING GROUNDS FOR SUSPENSION FROM RIDING BUS**

Conduct which provides grounds for suspension from bus riding privileges include:

- A. Inappropriate student conduct including, but not limited to behavior as outlined in District policies, FFC, FGAA, FGAB, FGAC, FGAD, FGAE, FGAF, FGAI, FH, and FHA.
- B. Willful injury or threat of injury to a bus driver or another rider.
- C. Willful and/or repeated defacement of the bus.
- D. Use of profanity after a warning.
- E. Repeated willful disobedience to a bus driver or other supervisor's directives.
- F. Such other behavior as the school administration deems to threaten the safe operation of the bus and its occupants

##### **2. USE OF VIDEO SURVEILLANCE ON SCHOOL BUSES**

Video cameras may be used on school buses when deemed advisable to monitor conduct and/or to maintain a safe environment for students and employees.

##### **3. SECURITY OF VIDEO SURVEILLANCE**

The content of surveillance video tapes constitutes student records that are confidential and protected. Only those having a legitimate educational or administrative purpose shall be able to review such information. If a tape becomes the subject of a disciplinary proceeding, it shall be treated like all other evidence in the hearing as confidential and protected.
