- · Review minutes from last meeting -
 - Mrs. Kramer reviewed amendments that were voted on last October
- Update on spending for current year
 - Mrs. Kramer explained that teachers are still spending the money allotted to their department, but that they have been given a March 31 deadline so that invoices can be paid by the end of June to close out the books for the fiscal year.
- Amendments needed there are no amendments needed at this time.
 - Mrs. Kramer read the caveat written in the plan that allows for the purchase of more computers if needed. Mr. Allen will be replacing half the computers in the lab with funding available and will replace the other computers with funding from 2021/2022 if approved by the council.
- School Improvement Plan for 2021/2022
 - Mrs. Kramer explained that the school has a SIP that was written in 2019 and was not updated last year due to Covid and the school shutting down. She explained that the Trustlands spending plan with goals are based on the SIP, but need to be written with academics at the forefront. She would like to change goal #6 to read, "Increase college and career readiness among students." The Community Council agreed that the change of the goal was good.
- Goals for 2021/2022
 - Mrs. Kramer is keeping a list of action plan steps and needs for the coming year as she begins writing the plan. She will email a rough draft of the plan for next year to each committee member to view before the next meeting, where changes can be made if warranted and the committee will vote on approving the plan.
