To make it easier for parents, the students are allotted a time slot by last name, and all students in one family can come at the same time. Registration will be held at the Tintic District Office, 545 East Main, for both High School and Elementary students, with coordinated times.

<u>Student information form</u>: We encourage you to go to the Tintic School District website <u>www.tintic.org</u>, follow the parent link and complete this ahead of time. The document will automatically be sent to our office when you select the submit button at the bottom of the form.

*If you do not have access to a computer or the internet, we will have computers available for you to use with the help of assistants at registration.

This registration is mandatory for all new and returning students.

On the date and time listed above parents will need to pick up, fill out and submit all enrollment/registration forms (including supporting documents). These forms include: Computer User Agreement, Bus form, Free & Reduced lunch form, Student Media Release Form, Chromebook agreement and locker assignment.

Course Selection: At this time students will be able to select and review courses offered and analyze the needed courses for graduation, electives and continuing education

7th Grade Orientation: All 7th Grade students will meet at the Tintic District Office for the 7th Grade Orientation on Tuesday, August 9th @ 1:00pm. Here students will receive their course schedules, locker assignments, locks for lockers and be given a building tour of THS. This is a great opportunity for parents and students to familiarize themselves with the school and to also address any questions they may have.

New THS Students: Mrs. Okelberry, the school counselor will be meeting with new $8^{th} - 12^{th}$ grade students and their parents/guardians to review their transcript and select their courses for the 2016 -2017 school year during the above scheduled times.

Opening Day: The opening day of the 2016 - 2017 school year will be Wednesday, August 17th. First period will begin at 7:50 a.m. Students should expect all teachers to review their course syllabus, grading policies, and classroom expectations on the first day of school. Students should bring a notebook and a pen/pencil on the first day of school.

Course Schedule: Course schedules will be given to students at registration. The school counselor will make any necessary changes to individual schedules at that time. Students who do not attend registration will need to come to the office before 1st period on the first day of school to pick up their schedule and turn in required registration documents, receive a locker assignment, etc.

Textbooks: Textbooks will be distributed to students during the first two days of school. Students are responsible for all textbooks, library books, and other materials checked out to them. Students will be required to pay for books or materials lost or not returned at the end of the school year.

Lockers: Each student will be assigned a locker for their textbooks. Students may only use locks supplied through the THS office on their lockers. Any unauthorized locks will be removed. Students should not share their lockers with other students or give out their lock combinations to friends.

Bell Schedule: Tintic High School will be on traditional schedule during the 2016-2017 school year. Mondays – Thursdays will be a seven period day and classes will be 56 minutes in length. Students will be enrolled in seven classes and will attend school from 7:50 a.m. to 3:25 p.m. NO School on Fridays.
